Argentina Rock Climbing Course Itinerary

This is a flexible trip itinerary that shows the general progression of the trip. Our exact schedule will depend highly on the weather, strength of the group, and time of year.

Day 0: Arrive into Mendoza, Argentina. Generally we'll have a 6:00pm meeting the evening before the course.

Day 1: We'll go over equipment and food for the next 12 days, and travel from Mendoza, south towards the Cajon de Arenales. The evening will find us setting up camp beneath towering granite walls.

Day 2 - 5: After reviewing the basics, you will dive into a progressive, hands on curriculum designed to create competent and confident leaders in a vertical environment. You will practice building complex anchors, self-rescue, and mock leading on a series of sport, trad, and alpine rock routes.

Day 6 - 11: Towards the end of the rock course, you will apply your skills on multi-pitch alpine routes in the Arenales basin. You will continue to develop your leadership and route-finding skills in this amazing location.
